Daytime Classroom Assistant/Tutor for Entry Level ESL Classes

Mondays, Wednesdays or Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. or Fridays from 9 a.m. to noon

Assist the teacher to conduct activities, provide assistance to adult students with questions, and work one-to-one or in small groups with students as assigned by the teacher. Gain the satisfaction of seeing the increase in the students' English skills - speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Daytime Classroom Assistant/Tutor for Mid-Level ESL Classes

Tuesdays, and/or Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Work collaboratively with ESL Teacher to implement lesson plans (prepared by Licensed ESL teacher), conduct activities, assist with computer lab study, and lead small conversation and reading groups. Develop trusting and supportive relationships with adult students. Sharpen your tutoring skills while experiencing the satisfaction of watching the improvements in students' English speaking, listening, reading, and writing abilities.

Daytime Classroom Assistant/Tutor for Academics Classes

Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Assist the teacher to conduct activities, provide assistance to low-level adult academics students with questions, and work one-to-one or in small groups with students as assigned by the teacher. Sharpen your tutoring skills while experiencing the satisfaction of watching the improvements in students' reading, math, grammar, reading and writing abilities.

Daytime Classroom Assistants/Tutors for Low-Level Literacy Class for Adult Learners

Tuesdays or Thursdays from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Assist adult students learning to read or write for the first time or attempting to improve their basic reading/writing skills. Work with Lead Volunteer(s) who plan the lessons and help tutors with methods to approach a reading skill with a learner. Tutors will work one-to-one and in small groups with adult students.

Evening Classroom Assistant/Tutor for Entry and Mid-Level ESL Classes

Mondays (Entry-Level) or Tuesday or Thursday (Mid-Level) from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

Assist the teacher to conduct activities, provide assistance to adult students with questions, and work one-to-one or in small groups with students as assigned by the teacher. Gain the satisfaction of seeing the increase in the students' English skills - speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Evening Classroom Assistant/Tutor for Entry through Upper-Level Math Class

Thursdays from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

Assist the teacher to provide assistance to adult students with entry through upper-level Math questions, and work one-to-one or in small groups with students as assigned by the teacher. Sharpen your tutoring skills while experiencing the satisfaction of watching the improvements in students' math abilities.

Note: Volunteers generally volunteer about 2 to 4 hours per week during the school year from the beginning of September through the end of June.
